

## Dusting the petals

We're going to dust the petals using edible dust in pink and a little bit of green, then mix them together. A tip for coloring: don't pick up too much dust at once. Start with a small amount, and if the color isn't intense enough, gradually add more.

Dust from the bottom of the petal toward the center, following the direction of the veins. Then, dust from the top toward the center in the same way. For the back of the petal, use the same technique. Repeat this process for all the petals.

## Assembling the flower

Take the stigma and green floral tape. Then, we'll attach the stigma and petals together. Position the stigma in the center of the two petals. Wrap the tape around the stem downwards. Then, add two more petals and tape again until you have taped all four petals to the stigma. Make sure that everything is even, the height and the width.

There you have it! Dogwood flower made with gumpaste!  
If you want a bigger Dogwood flower you can adjust with buying a bigger cutter for the petal, you can also make any color that you want.
